



REACHING ASIA & ISRAEL

In 1978, Singapore was prophesied to be the Antioch of Asia. But what does it actually mean? Just like how the Antioch church in Acts 13 created positive regional impact, the Church in Singapore predestined by God as the “Antioch of Asia”, needs to rise up to her call to reach and impact Asia with the Good News.

Asia is the most religiously diverse continent and home to almost 60% of the world’s population. Asia today is the least-Christian major area in the world by percentage with only 9% or 388 million of the total Asian population as Christians. However, Christianity is expected to grow faster compared to other religions in Asia.

RiverLife works with churches in the cities to reach their neighbouring villages and islands that have little Christian presence. In December 2018, we held 12 evangelistic rallies across north and central Philippines where many received healing and were touched by the presence of God. This helped to establish the newly planted churches. Bible studies were also formed to disciple the new believers.
