SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Understand the Antioch mandate and the significance of the Antioch Church.
- 2. Go on a mission trip this year.

SERMON SUMMARY

As a church in Singapore, our calling is clear – to be the Antioch of Asia. This message seeks to help RiverLifers contextualise and embrace the Antioch mandate by understanding the significance of the church in Antioch and learning the heart of the Antioch mandate. Let's challenge ourselves to catch the heart of the Antioch mandate by pursuing the heart of God.

SERMON RECAP

Antioch has a special significance for Singapore Christians. It is a rally cry issued by Billy Graham in 1978 for Singapore to be the Antioch of Asia.

What do we know about the Antioch Church and its mandate?

1. About Antioch

- Antioch is a large city. It is prosperous and rich in culture.
- Antioch is extremely popular and extremely busy.
- Antioch is also evil immoral and sin-filled.
- However, God found the most unlikely and ungodly place to plant the first Gentile church.

2. Significance of Antioch

- The Antioch Church is the beachhead to launch the gospel into the world (Acts 1:8).
- It is a greenhouse for the new moves of God, for revival and salvations, for the prophetic, and for true genuine love and compassion to grow among the believers.

3. The Heart of Antioch

- a) The heart of Antioch was to reach the needy (Acts 11:27-29)
 - The believers were not only "God chasers", but sacrificial givers.
 - The Antioch Christians were poor and persecuted, but they were generous.
 - Proverbs 19:17
- b) The heart of Antioch was to reach the lost and the world (Acts 13:2)
 - Antioch became the base where the gospel is to be preached to the ends of the earth.
 - The believers at Antioch caught the heart and pulse of Antioch as they caught hold of God's heart.

4. Arise, Antioch

- The Antioch Church was prepared, ready to obey and willing (Acts 13:2-3).
- Ps Joachim urges us to arise from our slumber and do great things for God.
- Things in the spiritual realm are shifting, and we need the Antioch of today to be ready.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What is the heart of the Antioch Church?
- 2. The Antioch Church is a greenhouse for genuine love and compassion to grow among believers. How do you grow your love and compassion for others?
- 3. Let's rediscover missions together by embarking on a mission trip this year either with your cell group, your family or even yourself.

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray for us to have the passion to pursue God's heart.
- Pray for us to have the obedience and courage to go wherever and whenever God calls.

2. World

- Pray for those affected by the aftermath of the Turkey-Syria earthquake.
- Pray for those affected by the aftermath of the Cyclone Gabrielle in New Zealand.
- Pray for a swift end to the COVID-19 crisis globally, if not a reduction in cases in third-world nations, and a stable environment where humans and virus coexist.
- Pray for peace especially in the Russia-Ukraine war and in the US-China conflict.

3. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
