TOPIC: THE PRECIOUS GIFT | SCRIPTURE: VARIOUS PASSAGES

SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

1. Understand that Jesus is the most precious gift that believers should hold onto tightly.
2. Grasp the magnitude of God's love for everyone – believers and non-believers.

SERMON SUMMARY

Christmas is about God giving the most precious, priceless gift to humanity – Jesus Christ. There are four great truths to this precious gift – it came from heaven, it changes everything for us, it is a personalised gift, and it was given to meet our greatest need. May we all cherish this precious gift God has given us.

SERMON RECAP

1. This precious gift comes from heaven

- This is the most priceless gift from heaven. And it now belongs to us.
- This is no ordinary gift. The gift that God has given to all mankind comes from heaven. This gift is the Lord Jesus Christ ([Philippians 2:9-10](#)).
- No gift in this universe and all throughout heaven can match this most precious gift given to us by God ([Isaiah 9:6](#)). It is the ultimate gift heaven ever had and could offer for all eternity.
- The ultimate, unrivalled, precious gift from heaven ([John 3:13](#)) was given to us.
- In [John 3:16](#), the word 'so' in the original Greek language is an adverb for "intensity". You will never give a priceless precious gift to anyone, unless you love that person deeply. During the first Christmas, God showed His deepest love for us by giving us the ultimate gift called Jesus Christ. This precious gift also showed the value God had placed on humanity ([Galatians 3:13](#)).

2. This precious gift changes everything for us

- This gift has such a deep and lasting impact that it will transform our lives forever.
- [Galatians 5:1](#), [John 8:36](#) – this gift will set us free.
- Receiving this gift from heaven transforms our lives.

3. The precious gift is a personalised gift

- Jesus is a personalised gift that is not manufactured and not random. God had us in mind when He gave Jesus to the world.
- He knows our needs. He knows our cries. He knows our fears. Jesus is our personal friend, our personal saviour. He is our comforter and our healer.

4. This gift was given to meet our greatest need

- [Isaiah 9:6](#) – God will not waste the most precious gift if He felt that we don't need it.
- We needed a Saviour ([Luke 2:11](#)). We needed salvation ([John 3:16-17](#)).
- We needed to be saved from our sin ([Romans 6:23](#)), we needed to be saved from the judgement of our sins, and we needed to be saved from the pits of hell so that we can be reunited with God our Father.

Conclusion:

- When we receive this gift, we have to open it. This gift can remain unopened if we put it aside and continue with life.
- You can choose to open it and have this precious gift with you as you journey through life.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. One of the truths of this precious gift is that it was given to meet our greatest need. What is one of the needs you have that only Jesus can meet/fulfil? How did Jesus meet that need?
2. Share with your cell how this precious gift has changed your life forever.
3. Is there anyone that you would like to share this gift? Come up with practical ways to do that.

WORKS

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray for RiverLifers to always be thankful for this precious gift and to hold it tightly.
- Pray for our brothers and sisters who have backslid to return to Christ.

2. RiverLife

- Pray for our church that as we have concluded the 21 days of prayer and fasting, we will be determined to live in a new normal – one that follows after the example of Christ.

3. World

- Pray for the situation Iceland where a volcanic eruption is affecting the nation.
- Continue to pray for the conflict in the Gaza Strip between Israel and Hamas - for both nations to reach a ceasefire resolution.
- Pray for the situation in China where Beijing hospitals have a sudden surge in respiratory illnesses among children.
- Pray for the COVID-19 surge in Singapore.
- Continue to pray for the Russia-Ukraine war and the avoidance of using nuclear weapons.
- Continue to pray for the civil unrest in Myanmar.

4. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
