2. Consider how living these truths would have an impact on our walk with God and interactions with others.

SERMON SUMMARY

God has loved and favored us:

1. At Creation
 - a. We are made in God's image (**Genesis 1:26 – 27**)
 - b. We were crowned with glory, honour and dominion (**Psalm 8:4-6**)
2. In Our Redemption
 - a. We are precious enough for Jesus to die in our place (**John 3:16, Romans 5:6-8**)
 - b. We are given unlimited grace and mercy (**1 John 1:9, Psalm 103:8-12**)
 - c. We are adopted into God's family (**Ephesians 1:4-5**)
 - d. We are appointed as co-heirs with Christ (**Romans 8:16-17, Ephesians 1:3**)
3. In Our Glorification
 - a. We are destined to reign with Christ (**Revelation 5:9-10**)
 - b. We will judge the world and angels (**1 Corinthians 6:1-3**)

SERMON RECAP

What matters is what God thinks of us.

God has loved and favored us:

1. At Creation
 - a. We are made in God's image (**Genesis 1:26 – 27**)
 - Moses repeated thrice that we are made in God's image – we are made compatible to Him
 - Personality: we have unique personalities, none of us are the same
 - Morality: We can distinguish between good and evil
 - Spirituality: We are able to engage with God and worship Him
 - We are precious as we are made in His image
 - b. We were crowned with glory, honour and dominion (**Psalm 8:4-6**)
 - We are the crown of God's creation and given dominion over this earth
 - God has a high regard over humanity
 - The evil one has tried to destroy mankind and man fell as a result
 - However, God deems us precious to redeem us through the death of Jesus Christ.
2. In Our Redemption
 - a. We are precious enough for Jesus to die in our place (**John 3:16, Romans 5:6-8**)
 - CT Studd wrote this in response to a revelation of his worth - "If Jesus Christ be God and died for me, then no sacrifice can be too great for me to make for Him." He gave up everything and went to serve God in the mission field where he died.

- b. We are given unlimited grace and mercy ([1 John 1:9](#), [Psalm 103:8-12](#))
 - God has lavished us great mercy and grace by sending Jesus to die for our sins
 - c. We are adopted into God's family ([Ephesians 1:4-5](#))
 - God loved us in Christ even before He made the world – He knew that we would have sinned against Him, but He still chose for us to come into being.
 - d. We are appointed as co-heirs with Christ ([Romans 8:16-17](#), [Ephesians 1:3](#))
 - We are made to also inherit all that will be given to Jesus – glory, honour, power and authority to rule the world.
 - We have been blessed with different spiritual blessings e.g.
 - Indwelling of the Holy Spirit
 - Intimacy with God
 - Knowing Our Life purpose
 - Receiving Answered Prayers
 - Ability to understand God's Word and spiritual truths
 - Fruit of the Spirit – Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness and Self-control
 - Authority to pray for others with the Spirit's power
3. In Our Glorification
- a. We are destined to reign with Christ ([Revelation 5:9-10](#))
 - b. We will judge the world and angels ([1 Corinthians 6:1-3](#))
 - In the end times, we will be under God's leading and given the right to judge the world and angels.

We can only enjoy deep intimacy with our Father when we allow the Holy Spirit to reveal what *sonship* really means! ([Romans 8:15-17](#)).

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are some beliefs you hold on to that may hinder you from living as a son/daughter of God, and in the fullness of God's love?
2. Pastor Lionel provided 8 truths about our sonship in Christ. How much do each of these truths do you believe in your mind, heart and spirit?
3. How would living these truths help us in our walk with God? What would others also observe about us as we live out these truths? Would it make a difference in our daily lives and interactions with others?

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray that we will grow in a deeper understanding of the extent of God's love for us
- Pray that God will continue to reveal to us any ungodly beliefs and to submit it to the Lordship of Christ
- Pray that God will empower us to live an abundant life that will glorify Him.

2. RiverLife

- Pray for our church, that as we enter into a season of prayer and fasting, that God will align all of our hearts and do what He needs to do so that we can live in a new normal that glorifies Him.

3. World

- Continue to pray for the various nations that are at war:
 - a. Russia and Ukraine
 - b. Myanmar (Civil War) – Pray for the situation where military service was made compulsory for man and woman between the ages of 18 and 35.
 - c. Israel & Hamas – Pray for the truce talks between Israel and Palestine in Cairo, that a peaceful resolution can be reached.
- Continue to pray for countries that have an escalated conflict situation:
 - a. Japan, China and the Philippines in the South China Sea
 - b. North & South Korea
- Continue to pray for countries recovering from recent natural disasters:
 - a. Taiwan (Earthquake)
 - b. Indonesia (Volcanic Eruption)
 - c. South East Asia – Heatwave across various countries
- Pray for Singapore
 - a. Pray for the family of the 2 victims that were killed in a road accident at Tampines
 - b. Pray for a smooth transition from PM Lee to incoming PM Lawrence Wong
 - c. Pray for a stability in the cost of living in Singapore
- Other Global Issues
 - a. Pray for the at Columbia University where pro-Palestinian demonstrations are turning violent.

4. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
