## SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

1. Recognize that human institutions have also been given authority by God

## SERMON SUMMARY

Ps Lionel shares a recap of Spiritual Authority and speaks about how human institutions are also given authority over those under their charge. He also shares about the spiritual authority leaders hold and the importance of keeping our spiritual umbrella intact.

## SERMON RECAP

### a. Recap of Spiritual Authority

1. What is Spiritual Authority?
  - God- given right to receive and use God’s power that flows from the indwelling of the Holy Spirit
  - Only a born-again believer can exercise spiritual authority
  - We have the right to pray and bless others. We must learn how to steward it well.

*“It is like using Jesus’ credit card of authority, power, and resources to make beneficial transactions in the spiritual realm.” - Charles Kraft*

2. The Origin of Spiritual Authority
  - God gave man the authority to rule the earth. However, the Devil usurped Man’s authority and rules the world. Jesus came and destroyed the Devil’s works. Through His obedience, Jesus receives God’s highest authority. Jesus delegates His authority to all believers so that we can make disciples of all nations
3. Satan still holds some power today (1 Peter 5:8-9, James 4:7)
  - While Satan has been defeated by Jesus at the Cross, God in His sovereignty has not totally removed all of Satan’s power today
4. Two Competing Powers in Our World Today

5. Spiritual Authority of believers
  - Right to pray effective prayers ([Mark 11:2 -24](#))
  - Right to bless others ([Numbers 6:22-27](#))
  - Right to overcome Satan ([Luke 10: 17-20](#))
  - Right to preach the gospel with power ([Mark 16:15-18](#))
6. Purpose of Spiritual Authority
  - Enables believers to live a life of freedom, victory and fruitfulness
  - Gives believers the power to pray, bless and protect those under their charge
  - Gives believers the power to preach the Gospel with signs and breakthroughs

**b. Human Institutions and Authority**

1. God established human institutions for orderly function of society
  - King and Government
  - School
  - Church
  - Secular Organization
  - Family Unit
2. Authority is given to every human institution.

3. God and the spirit world honour human authority ([Numbers 30:3-9](#))

**c. Additional Authority Given to Spiritual Leaders**

1. Authority to pray for spiritual wellbeing and physical healing ([Ephesians 1:17-18](#), [James 5:14-15](#))
  - Ps Lionel also exhorted the congregation to continue to trust God while waiting for God’s healing.
2. Authority to impart spiritual gifts ([Romans 1:11-12](#), [2 Timothy 1:6](#))
  - God has given leaders the privilege to bless and impart spiritual gifts to His people
3. Authority to protect subjects from Satanic attack ([Luke 22:31-32](#))
  - Leaders of the different institutions are given spiritual authority to shield their subjects
4. Authority to shape the spiritual atmosphere of their institution ([2 Kings 18:5-7](#), [2 Kings 20:1-3](#), [11](#))
  - Through the book of 2 Kings, we see how the nation prospers when a godly king sits on the throne and how the people would suffer when an evil king is on the throne.
  - God has given spiritual authority to leaders to bless the people.

**d. Keeping Our Spiritual Umbrella Intact**

1. God's authority structure in the home (**Colossians 3:18-21**)

- Ps Lionel shared about the Biblical Order of the family.
- Christ is the largest umbrella covering all
- Christ covering the husband – husband's role is to protect, lead and provide for the family
- Husband providing the covering for the wife – wife's role is to comfort, teach and nurture
- Wife provides the covering of the children – children's role is to love and obey parents
- We are to consider if the umbrella we have is big enough to provide covering for those under our care.
- As leaders, we have great responsibility to steward our spiritual authority well, as we short-change our people when we are careless in our spiritual walk, or we neglect to use our spiritual authority

2. How can we keep our spiritual umbrella intact?

- Consecrate ourselves and our group to God (**Romans 12:1-2**)
- Keep walking in step with the Holy Spirit (**Galatians 5:16**)
- Be diligent in shepherding our people (**1 Peter 5:1-4**)

**e. Personal Application**

- The Tragic Story of Samson (**Judges 16:20-21**)



# Discussion Questions

1. From the sermon, what are reasons God has elected people to act as our spiritual authority? What are the characteristics these people have to display and abide by? How can we as sheep also support and look out for our leaders?
2. What are some reflections for the story of Samson and how can you apply it in your own personal life?
3. As believers, what are the spheres of influence we have been placed in? How can we keep our spiritual umbrella intact? How can we support one another in keeping our umbrellas intact?

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

## 1. Sermon Application

- Pray for our church, that as we enter into a season of prayer and fasting, that God will align all of our hearts and do what He needs to do so that we can live in a new normal that glorifies Him.

## 3. World

- Continue to pray for the various nations that are at war:
  - a. Russia and Ukraine
  - b. Myanmar (Civil War) – Pray for the situation where military service was made compulsory for man and woman between the ages of 18 and 35.
  - c. Israel & Hamas – Pray for the truce talks between Israel and Palestine in Cairo, that a peaceful resolution can be reached.
- Continue to pray for countries that have an escalated conflict situation:
  - a. Japan, China and the Philippines in the South China Sea
  - b. North & South Korea
- Continue to pray for countries recovering from recent natural disasters:
  - a. Taiwan (Earthquake)
  - b. Indonesia (Volcanic Eruption)
  - c. South East Asia – Heatwave across various countries
  - d. Canada (Wildfire)
- Pray for Singapore
  - a. Pray for PM Lawrence Wong and his cabinet as they begin a new chapter for Singapore
  - b. Pray for a stability in the cost of living in Singapore
  - c. Pray for those affected by the Singapore Airlines's SQ321 turbulence incident
- Other Global Issues
  - a. Pray for the United States of America as they gear up for this year end's election
  - b. Continue to pray for the medical strike in South Korea
  - c. Pray for the situation in various parts of Indonesia where 58 people are killed by cold lava and flash floods

## 4. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.



1. **SERMON SERIES: SPIRITUAL AUTHORITY.** 2-30 June 2024 One of the biggest truths that Christians tend to forget is this – we are in the midst of a spiritual war. For many Christians, the enemy seems to render them completely ineffective in this spiritual war – they are never a threat to the kingdom of darkness. Our prayer is that through this series, believers will start to exercise their God-given authority, and live victorious lives in their families, workplaces, and in the world.
