# **SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES**

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Understand that God uses waiting to transform us
- 2. Trust in God's goodness today and his faithfulness tomorrow

# **SERMON SUMMARY**

Waiting on God is essential to usher His intent for us. We can expect God to use seasons of waiting to mould us into His likeness, prepare us for what He wants to do through us, and experience His best for us. We wait by trusting that He has a better plan than ours. We wait in humility knowing we are not in control. And we wait in obedience expecting Jesus to return and restore all things. The process of waiting and what God does in our lives during that time of waiting is as important as what we are waiting for.

# **SERMON RECAP**

No one likes to wait because it's not in our nature to wait. Waiting is very hard. Instant gratification is always preferred. But God is patient and never in a hurry. And He wants us to know how to wait while He works – according to His timetable. How do we wait well?

## 1. Wait on God with Enduring Trust (v 7b)

- In waiting, we can trust that God knows what He is doing
- In trusting, we can wait in expectant hope
- God is at work beneath the surface even when we can't see it
- Desire His timing, not only His resources (2 Peter 3:8)
- God's work in our lives during waiting is as important as what we are waiting for

#### 2. Wait on God in Quiet Humility (v 9)

- In waiting, don't grumble, complain or blame others
- In humility, we recognise that we are not in control
- The single most important form that waiting takes is to pray and hear His voice
- God will renew our strength when we are willing to wait (Isaiah 40:31)

#### 3. Wait on God as an Act of Obedience (v 7-8)

- We ought to wait for His return where He will restore all things
- The return of the Lord ought to shape what and who we live for
- Sharing in His suffering and waiting go hand in hand with sharing in His glory
- Waiting is part of the process of us becoming what God wants us to be (Romans 5:3-5)

**Conclusion:** We need to wait and live on God's timing and not our own if we want to see His purposes and plans come to pass in our lives. Even in the Waiting, God is Building us and there is Beauty that can come no other way.

""The Lord is my portion,' says my soul, 'therefore I will hope in Him.' The Lord is good to those who wait for Him, to the soul who seeks Him." - Lamentations 3:24-25.

# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

# 1. Why is waiting on the Lord so difficult in today's day and age? What are the possible reasons why we struggle to wait on the Lord?

#### Leader's Notes

This is a recap question for members to discuss the challenges of waiting on God in a world of fast foods, wifi and Grab rides. Are we controlling time with our inventions and technologies, or is time controlling us by making us more impatient, anxious and edgy? Our mission is to tell the world that God is waiting for them, and yet we can't wait on God ourselves. Why?

#### **Resource**

#### **Transition**

As the world's values start to infiltrate the church, we find ourselves struggling like the world and we don't even know it.

2. Do you have an experience where you went ahead with your desires and not waiting on the Lord? What would you do differently now in order to wait upon the Lord?

#### Leader's Notes

This is a relate question for members to share their experiences in both waiting on God and/or going ahead of God, and how those experiences have shaped them and the lessons they have learned through them.

#### **Resource**

*How to wait on the Lord* by David Jeremiah

#### **Transition**

Even when we fumble in the waiting test and our plans go awry, it will not derail the plans of God. Jesus has promised to return and make all things new. We can at least wait on that, right?

# 3. What does "the return of the Lord" mean to you; and how does it affect you and the way you live today?

#### Leader's Notes

This is a response question for members to consider how we ought to live in light of Jesus' second coming. Encourage members to be real and transparent. Doctrinally perfect answers are not required here – only honest ones are!

#### **Resource**

Living in light of Jesus' return by Jason Allen

#### <u>Closing</u>

Waiting is a very active part of living. It's anything but passive. Waiting works its way out in very deliberate actions – intentionally searching the Scriptures and praying, and in humility acknowledge we are finite. There's more to learn from waiting than ploughing ahead without God.

# WORKS

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

### 1. Sermon Application

- Pray for God to help us to be humble in waiting and not get impatient and anxious
- Pray for God to help us surrender to His timing and in His purposes for our lives
- Pray that God will use our waiting and suffering to reveal His glory

### 2. World

- Pray for good weather in Singapore during this hot season.
- Pray for the tense situation along the straits of Taiwan.
- Pray for peace in the Russia-Ukraine war and in the US-China conflict.
- Pray for Thailand as they undergo the elections and appointment of a new government.
- Pray for peace in the Gaza strip (Israel) as violence erupts between Israel and Islamic Jihad.

## 3. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
