SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Seek God's direction on how we can serve the poor and the disadvantaged in the community.
- 2. Be intentional and purposeful when embarking on the work or task that He has called us to do.

SERMON SUMMARY

One of the key approaches for the church towards Biblical social justice is to uphold God's holy design for creation. God's just and loving nature is demonstrated in His creation of mankind. However, injustices mark many relationships that have gone wrong, starting with the family unit. As believers with both a natural and a spiritual family, we have a Biblical mandate and responsibility to address these injustices.

- In the area of family, recognise the "crossroads" we are at as a nation, understand the "ancient paths", and accept the "good way"
- Stand on God's unchanging and timeless precepts for marriage and family
- Speak the whole truth about family life, relationships and values in love
- **Sow** into a "just" family by daily living out husband-wife and parent-child relationships according to God's design

SERMON RECAP

- 1. Introduction (Deuteronomy 32:3-7)
 - God is a God of justice.
 - If we want to look at what justice looks like, we just need to look at God.
 - We are at the crossroads as a nation because it is up to the future generations on how they want to define family and traditional values.
- 2. Stand on God's unchanging design for families.
 - We need to return to the ancient paths:
 - God designed only 2 sexes (Genesis 1:27).
 - God designed marriages to be between a husband and a wife (Matthew 19:5)
 - God designed marriages to bear forth fruit parents and children (Genesis 9:7)
 - When we follow the ancient paths / God's design, we will enjoy God's blessings. (Leviticus 18:5)
 - When we deviate from God's design, we suffer undesirable consequences. (Jeremiah 6:17-21)
- 3. Stand. (Ephesians 6:14-15, Luke 18:7-8)

- The definition of a neutral stand on family will continue to shift as those with liberal views become more liberal and those with conservative views do not move in their stand.
- We need to stand on God's definitions and not move.

4. Speak. (Romans 10:13-14)

- Standing sometimes might not be sufficient. Sometimes, we are called to speak.
- Persecution in the world is very real especially cancel culture.
- But we need to still speak out the truth so that God's truth will go out there.
- Sometimes, "speaking" need not be in public but in the home.

5. Sow. (James 2:14)

- Apart from out verbal testimony, the testimony of our lives is just as loud.
- Sometimes, the best thing we can do is to invest in our marriages, our families and our children. This is a loud testimony to the world.
- Sow into the values and design of God for the families.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. In your observation of the Singapore society, in what ways have we as a nation departed from God's original design for marriage and family?

Leader's Notes

In this questions, you can draw out your member's observations of society. The following are some of the areas where society has departed from God's design:

- a) The re-definition of marriage due to the acceptance of the LGBTQ+ ideology.
- b) The devaluing of purity and sex within a marital relationship
- c) The reluctance for men to lead their households
- d) The reliance on pornography to satisfy one's physical desires
- e) Marriages not reflecting the glory of God as God designed it to be
- f) Children not submitting to the authority of their parents

Transition

All of these areas are departure from God's original design for marriages and the family unit. Therefore, it is critical for the church to shine it's light in such a time as this!

2. How can the church (you!) play it's role to move families and marriages back to God's original design?

Leader's Notes

This question is designed to help members examine their lives – "what can I do to play my part in God's kingdom for such a time as this?"

- Invest my time, energy and resources to make my marriage a thriving one.
- Strengthen my relationship with my children and to guide them in the ways of the Lord
- Seek help if I am addicted to pornography
- For singles to find their fulfilment in Christ
- To journey together with another couple so that together, God's glory can be made manifest in our marriages.
- To not remain silent on matters regarding the family, sexuality and marriages when the Singapore government requires input from its citizens.

3. After hearing this message, what is one practical thing you can do to "speak out" God's truth to the world out there – to your pre-believing friends, families and colleagues?

Leader's Notes

The world will never hear about God's truth and His design for families and marriages if the church does not proclaim the truth out there. Proclaiming the truth out there does not necessarily mean to preach the gospel. Sometimes, it may mean for us to show our pre-believing friends and family the beauty of God's design through our lives. Sometimes, is standing up for what we believe are God's truth for the family and marriages.

Closing

These are indeed dark times that we live in. But the church is meant to thrive in the dark because we are the light of the world. May we let our light shine so brightly in this day and age so that God's glory can be revealed through us to the world!

WORKS

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray for all our marriages to be strong and to reflect God's glory to the world.
- Pray for parents to bring up their children in the ways of the Lord
- Pray that Singapore will continue to hold on to the traditional values of the family

2. World

- Pray for those affected by the aftermath of the Turkey-Syria earthquake.
- Pray for the flood situation in Turkey
- Pray for a swift end to the COVID-19 crisis globally, if not a reduction in cases in third world nations, and a stable environment where humans and virus coexist.
- Pray for peace in the Russia-Ukraine war and in the US-China conflict.

3. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.

Reflection

Sacrifice is almost a bad word in the church today! We all love teachings on blessings and victory. But the truth is this – we serve a God who was willing to sacrifice His all for us. All of His disciples subsequently sacrificed their all as well – they all died as martyrs. As we reflect towards Good Friday, may we never forget that just like Christ, we too must learn to sacrifice of ourselves, our resources and our time for the sake of Christ. May we never be afraid to love others, especially those in need, beyond ourselves, because that is what Christ did for us on the cross!

Prayer Pointers

- 1. Ask the Lord to show you areas of your life that you are unwilling to sacrifice to Him. Commit these areas to Him once again.
- 2. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you someone that you can bless through sacrifice.
