## SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Examine our hearts and our understanding about Revival
- 2. Commit to developing the right posture as we embark on these 21 days of prayer and fasting as a Church

## **SERMON SUMMARY**

This is the first sermon of the series – Revive Us, Lord. Our guest Pastor Philip and Pastor Ben had a conversation about Revival and Pastor Philip shared on the following:

- 1. Facing revival when it breaks out
- 2. Shepherding revival when it spreads
- 3. The type of posture we should adopt during Revival

## **SERMON RECAP**

This is the first part of a 5-part sermon series "Revive Us, Lord".

- 1. 3 points about revival:
  - Revival is pulsating
    - Mass Salvation & Preaching of Gospel (Acts 19:10, 20, 17) During the Ephesus revival, the gospel spread far and wide. This resulted in many coming to hear about God.
    - Unusual Signs and Wonders (Acts: 19:11-12) Many were healed in miraculous ways.
  - Revival is Painful
    - When there is Revival, people will be convicted of the holiness of God and be convicted of sin, resulting in repentance.
  - Revival is Perturbing

## 2. Shepherding Revival

- It is giving scriptural guardrails to explain the events as the revival unfolds and how to continue to be open so as to keep the fire burning and not quench the Spirit.
- Examples of this in Acts: The Word of God spreads (Acts 19: 10, 20)
- Central to the heart of revival is the glory of God. All revivals see a fresh outpouring of God's glory that is tangible. It arrests people with a holy awe and holy terror in their lives, resulting in mass repentance, reverence and transformation.

- Centre of God's glory is His moral holiness. When revival comes, there is widespread repentance & cleansing This brings holiness further attracts a greater glory of God!
- The Fruits Seen (Matthew 7:17)
  - While it was messy during the Ephesus revival, there were also fruits seen.
  - The "mess" included the following: public confession of sins, public impropriety & naked chaos, public offence to people of other faiths and public disorder/ public disorder charges
  - However, the following fruits were also seen: Word of God grew, mass turning to Christ, confession & repentance, signs and wonders and miracles, demons expelled and people set free, public severance from demonic practices, widespread fear of the Lord in the city & region and the glory and name of the Lord was magnified.

#### 3. The State of our Hearts

- o How we see revival when it comes will depend on the state of our hearts at the time.
- If we are spiritually dry, we will be more doctrinally-bound than Jesus-loving and tend to use our mind and our doctrinal bias to judge harshly on any move of the Spirit. We will also ignore the fruits of the revival and keep pointing to the messes seen.
- o Pastor Philip encouraged us to adopt various postures as the state of our hearts
  - Be Jesus loving and Jesus centred
  - Be desperate for more of God
  - Be open to flow, not to control
  - Be humble, not proud
  - Fear God, not man
  - Hate sin and love grace

# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. What is your understanding of Revival? How is it similar or different to what Pastor Philip Lyn shared about Revival?

### Leader's Notes

This is a question for members to share about their view and understanding of revival. How is it different or similar to what we know? If the cell wishes, they may consider what are some of the outstanding differences they noticed between pre-revival Ephesus (Acts 18:19-21, Acts 19:8-10) and Ephesus in revival? Share some of these revival features and which would be the ones most striking to them, and which would be the ones most disturbing? Members can share their reason.

#### Resources

What is Revival and Where do we find it? - Desiring God

### Transition

Even as we hear about stories of revival, let's explore how we can play a part in shepherding Revival.

2. Shepherding revival requires for us to have a keen discernment for the work of the Lord and its fruits amidst the mess. Pastor Philip shared the importance of being open to God's work and not cherry-picking based on one or two bad moments. Share your thoughts on this.

#### Leader's Notes

This is a recap and reflect question for members to have a open conversation on the scriptural guardrails provided by Pastor Philip and be their own scriptural guardrails, if any. Pastor Philip

provided the following verses Acts 19: 10, 17, 18, 20, 26 as hints on how to discern what is of God, in sometimes dynamic and seemingly challenging situations. The intention is for the cell through this conversation is to be more alert to what is of God so as to be in step with the spirit.

#### Transition

Scripture has provided examples of revival. We can also learn from the recorded history of past revivals. God is still working today and He desires for us to experience revival.

3. How do we approach Revival? What is the state of our hearts? Take time to examine our postures and our actions – what are some areas we can continue to grow in and encourage one another as we ready ourselves for the work of the Lord?

### Leader's Notes

This is a reflect and response question for members to consider if there are areas (e.g., the "various postures" mentioned in the sermon recap) that may be hindering them from being active participants in God's work in our lives, our church, our city and beyond. Members can take time to examine the areas of their lives they need to submit to God and be accountable to each other to grow as a Church.

### Closing

Revival is a time of coming back to the Lord. Miraculous things beyond our imaginations will happen. It is important for us to keep our hearts and eyes open and to be discerning of what is of God's and what is not. He desires for us and the lost to know Him deeply. May we continue to pray for revival and allow God to start His transformative work in us towards Christlikeness!

### **WORKS**

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

## 1. Sermon Application

- Pray that we will allow God to work in our lives for a personal revival.
- Pray for strength and spiritual fervour as we continue to seek after Him.
- Pray that we will boldly proclaim the Gospel and favour with those around us.

## 2. RiverLife

 Pray for our church that God will revive us individually as we go through the 21-Days of Prayer and Fasting.

#### 3. World

- Pray for good weather in Singapore during this hot season. Pray also that there will not be any haze.
- Continue to pray for the Russia-Ukraine war and the avoidance of using nuclear weapons.
- Pray for the political scene in Singapore amidst all the scandals that have surfaced these 2 weeks.
- Pray for Japan as they release the Fukushima radioactive water into the ocean, as well as the nations that will be affected.

### 4. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
