SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Recognise the importance of Oneness in God and with each other
- 2. Commit to building the unity of the Church by loving God and each other as Christ does

SERMON SUMMARY

As we celebrate our 32rd anniversary, we are reminded of God's faithfulness and His desire for us to have a unity-centred life. He shows this to us in how the Trinity is united as One. He also prayed 3 times in John 17:21-22 that we may be one. Christian unity puts God's character on display (vv. 22 – 23) and we are called to place His Kingdom and righteousness above all personal desires and preferences. Jesus desires for us to experience a connectedness to Him and each other, and that we also act as the bridge to connect the lost to Him through our unity.

The enemy's constant work is fracturing relationships. When unity is absent, it turns people away. A disunited Christian community denies the message it proclaims through its behaviours. A disunified Church is not in Christ.

It is important for us to keep in mind this goal Christ has for us and to fight for unity together, through our love and actions for God and each other. May we also adopt Jesus' heart's cry to be One in Him.

SERMON RECAP

We thank God for His faithfulness to us over the years and through the recent 21 days of prayer and fasting. We reveal Jesus through Oneness (John 17:20-23), displaying His personality, purpose and power. In today's world full of divisions, the Church has a real opportunity to point others to Jesus.

Jesus prayed for two things

1. For Us to Become Perfectly One – a Oneness is based on the shared life of Jesus. Following Jesus begins our heart's journey towards Oneness. He gives us His presence to make us One and we reflect His glory as we are being transformed into His likeness. The word "complete" in v.23 is "wholeness", being made whole in Christ as we abide in Him and He dwelling in us. We experience deeper intimacy with others as we grow closer to Him.

We are called to have the same Oneness Jesus has with the Father and to reflect this closeness we have with Father God in our relationships. This Oneness with God (inner spiritual reality) produces Oneness with community (outward cooperation and harmony).

2. For us to bridge others to Him – for us to be the bridge to connect the broken to Jesus. He prayed that we would overflow into the world and transform the world. He has sent us so that the world may see the Father. Our Oneness sets us apart and tells the world two things: 1) Jesus is from God and 2) God's love is real as we express it in our lives. While people may have a hard time understanding and believing Jesus, they will be drawn to our relational Oneness as we learn to love God and each other well.

God's love unites and unity only comes when we choose to love one another as Christ loved us. Oneness is in line with the Gospel. We are called to be peacemakers and to focus on what unites us. We can trust God to heal us as we journey with Him through reconciliation of hurts and divisions. With godly lives, Gospel proclamation and visible unity, we reveal the truth that God sent His son to reconcile us to the Father.

Jesus prays for us to be One and this Oneness is a reflection of the oneness of the Father and the Son. The church being a unified witness to others is a high calling and points people to Jesus to follow Him. Jesus' prayer for us to be One means that it is possible in Jesus – we can desire what He desires and live in it fully. Make us One, Lord!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. God's manifest presence is attracted to unity (Psalm 133, Acts 1:4, 2:1) He deeply desires for us to be united (John 17:20-23). What is unity so important for the Church?

Leader's Notes

Leaders can invite members to read through the verses, for members to consider the reasons why Jesus prayed for the Church to be one. The cell can also consider the following questions - What is the importance of unity? What does a unity centred on Christ look like in this present age? What are the challenges foreseen that may cause division and what would need to be put in place to preserve unity?

Transition

The church is a living organism and there will be challenges as we grow in Christ as we are all continue to grow in Christlikeness. However, we must not lose sight of the unity God desires for us. He deeply desires for us to grow in Him and with a godly community.

2. What are some changes you would need to make or steps you would need to take (i.e., baptism, church membership) in your life if you are to pursue greater Oneness with Christ followers?

Leader's Notes

Leaders can invite members to consider aspects of their lives that may hinder the members pursuing greater Oneness with Christ followers i.e., examining our heart attitudes about areas of our lives, repentance, forgiveness, reconciliation, submitting our past hurts to God, stepping out of our comfort zone to love others more, commitment to physical cell and service, taking the step of declaration through baptism and committing to be part of the church through church membership. Leaders can choose to break into smaller groups to share and pray for each other.

<u>Note</u>: Oneness requires that we belong to a spiritual community. When we are rooted in a spiritual community, we are allowing ourselves to journey through life together with other fellow sojourners, and allowing spiritual fathers to speak into our life. That is why church membership is so critical for a believer. It is a commitment to being rooted in a local church and to be discipled. If you have members that have not made that commitment to be a part of RiverLife Church, encourage them to do so by attending the Joining the Family session. Details:

Transition

As we take steps to commit to our community, let us also examine how we can be a shining light to those around us.

3. How is a united community a reflection of Jesus and share an example / experience of how it reflects Christ. What are some ways we can love the lost together as a Church?

Leader's Notes

This question aims to let members consider how the characteristics of a united community reflects Christ e.g., showing love to each other and being kind in our words and choosing to love God together as a community. It will be good if members could share a personal experience or an example they had heard of. This helps provide a real-life example for members to consider. Leaders can also invite members to consider how the cell can choose to love the lost together e.g., reaching out to new visitors, serving in RiverLife Community Services or going on a mission trip together.

Closing

May we catch the heart of God in being one in Christ and being connected with each other, for the church to be a shining testimony of His goodness and to draw others to God as we draw close to Him!

PRAYER

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray for us to see the importance of Christian Unity
- Pray for us that God will search our hearts and reveal to us what is hindering us in our unity and growth as a Church
- Pray for conviction and strength as we take the step to grow in Unity in Christ and with each other

2. RiverLife

Pray for our church that as we have concluded the 21 days of prayer and fasting, we will
determine to live in a new normal – one that follows after the example of Christ.

3. World

- Continue to pray for the Russia-Ukraine war and the avoidance of using nuclear weapons.
- Pray for Singapore as we approach the presidential election that a Godly president will be elected.

- Pray for Hawaii as catastrophic wild fires are sweeping through the various islands and towns recover from the aftermath.
- Pray for the situation in southwestern China where rainstorms are triggering floods, resulting in dozens of missing people, and community devastation.
- Pray for the situation in Japan where radioactive water is released in to the Pacific Ocean.

4. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
