SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Recognise the marks of a Revitalised Church
- 2. Commit to seeing the Great Commission fulfilled

SERMON SUMMARY

The Early Church was deeply revitalised by the baptism of the Holy Spirit. It gave the Church a renewed purpose, boldness and courage, and a relentless desire to see the Great Commission fulfilled.

Ps Joachim gives 4 marks of a revitalised Church
#1: A revitalised Church is bold and courageous (Acts 4:23-31, 7:57 – 8:4)
#2: A revitalised Church is generous (Acts 2:45, Acts 4:32-35)
#3: A revitalised Church is empowered
#4: A revitalised Church is relentless in fulfilling the Great Commission

As we are revitalised, may we also choose to be outward looking and see how we can be his channels of blessing to those who have yet to know Him.

SERMON RECAP

Following the death of Jesus, the early Church was on the verge of collapse. Jesus, their leader, was crucified and killed. The disciples (the church) were fearful and lost their mission, vision, heart and faith (John 20:19).

However, God had a plan. The Holy Spirit moved powerfully and revitalised the Church. The disciples were bold, generous and courageous and in complete unity. It moved in great authority and power, and in step with the Holy Spirit. It was strong in prayer, intercession and worship. The Church was given a renewed purpose and a relentless desire to see the Great Commission fulfilled.

Ps Joachim covers 4 marks of a revitalised Church:

#1: A revitalised Church is bold and courageous (Acts 4:23-31, 7:57 - 8:4)

- The disciples moved from being fearful to people who proclaimed the gospel bravely. They lived as those placing great priority on the Gospel instead of their own lives, persevering in spite of the persecution they knew they would encounter.
- In Acts 4, the Church praised God for His goodness after Peter and John were released from prison (vv.23-24) and prayed for boldness to speak His word (vv.29-31)
- Though the disciples were scattered following the martyrdom of Stephen and by Saul's persecution, they continued preaching the word where they went (Acts 7:57 8:4)

#2: A revitalised Church is generous (Acts 2:45, Acts 4:32-35)

- "Zacchaeus spent an hour with Jesus and spent the rest of his life giving." Reinhard Bonnke
- The early church's view of earthly possessions and wealth shifted following their encounter with Jesus
- Ps Joachim shared about the generosity of the Chinese congregation to help the people of the Chin state in Myammar when they heard that the people were in need, as well as RiverLife's giving to the Kayah state of Myammar through the ongoing rice and food distributions.
- God sees our generosity and it is a privilege to partner with Him in this.

#3: A revitalised Church is empowered

- As we pursue God and live surrendered lives, He will empower us with His grace and anointing.
- He will enable us to thrive where we are placed, for His glory.

#4: A revitalised Church is relentless in fulfilling the Great Commission

- The disciples were relentless in bringing the Gospel as far as they could.
- They understood that the Church was made for God; and that the Church was sent to the world.
- They recognised the cost that Jesus paid and the importance of letting everyone hear the Gospel and be redeemed by the blood of the Lamb.
- Will we choose to take up the mantle and to obey God in fulfilling this Great Commission?

The revitalised Church brings life and the Good News wherever it goes. May we keep our hearts sensitive to God's leading and heart for the Church and the lost.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share a moment where you experienced being revitalised by God. How did it happen and how did it transform you and the areas of your life (e.g., being bold and courageous, generous, empowered in your relationships, work, school, service, etc.)?

Leader's Notes

This is a relate and recap question for members to share about a time they experienced God in a deeper measure. This could be due to the recent 21 days of prayer and fasting, or other times where they had breakthroughs through their own quiet time, camp etc. Leaders can also encourage members to consider moments where they may also have been revitalised through the quiet conviction of the Holy Spirit, or times they were empowered and encouraged by God. This question aims for members to look at how experiencing God in intimacy helped empower them in their lives (e.g., how it changed their worldview on things, how did it lead them to choose to honour God in their family, work, friendships etc.). Leaders can also invite members to share possible challenges they faced during those times and how they overcame it bearing in mind that spiritual attacks can also occur during those times.

Transition

God changes us from the inside out when we are revitalised by Him.

2. We have been blessed by God through the 21 days of prayer and fasting. How can we remain in the posture of a revitalised Church? How can we keep our fire burning and what are some hindrances that may cause us to lose sight or distract us from what He has called us to be?

Leader's Notes

This is a relate and reflect question for members to consider the times when they were revitalised by God. How were members able to sustain after that time? This is for members to consider what are some matters / routines that may draw us away from what God has intended for us, and for

us to consider putting in margins in our lives so that we may continue to abide in Him and bear fruit.

Transition

It is important for us to be mindful of the challenges we may face as we seek God and to remember to focus on His will.

3. Share with the cell where God has challenged you to be relentless in answering the Great Commission this season. What are the challenges and small victories you have experienced?

Leader's Notes

Leaders can invite members to share about where God has convicted them to be His witness in their lives. Members can also form smaller groups to pray for each other – e.g., being a testimony in their families, schools, workplaces as they share about the challenges and victories they have encountered. Leaders can also invite members to share if they have had past experiences in seeing salvation in the mission field or in their own local community as a way to encourage each other.

Closing

God will equip and empower us to do His work. May we say Yes to Him and walk in obedience and His anointing!

PRAYER

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray for us to seek revitalisation in our spiritual walk and to have a renewed hunger for God.
- Pray for us that we will be sensitive to God's leading where He has placed us to be witnesses and to obey joyfully and partner with Him as we follow His leading.
- Pray for spiritual protection as we live out His mandate of the Great Commission.

2. RiverLife

- Pray for our church that as we have concluded the 21 days of prayer and fasting, we will determine to live in a new normal one that follows after the example of Christ.
- Pray for our mission teams that are heading to the nations in this season.

3. World

- Pray for Morocco that just experienced a devastating earthquake with more than 2000+ fatalities and many more affected.
- Pray for our new President that the Lord will bestow upon him wisdom to lead the country in alignment with the ways of God.
- Pray for Hong Kong and Southern China as they battle Super Typhoon Saola, Black Rain and flooding.
- Pray for the wild fires and haze situations in Indonesia's Kalimantan and Sumatra areas.
- Pray for the Presidential election in Taiwan that a Godly leader will be elected.
- Continue to pray for the Russia-Ukraine war and the avoidance of using nuclear weapons.

4. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
