Date: 25 Feb 2024 | Speaker: Elder Lee Ee Yang | Topic: Lessons for the Joshua Generation | Scripture: Joshua 4:19-24

SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Be reminded of God's goodness in our lives and to hunger for more of His presence
- 2. Be reminded of the importance of humility and obedience in our walk with God

SERMON SUMMARY

Elder Ee Yang shared with us three lessons from the Joshua Generation as they entered the Promised Land:

Lesson #1 – Humility is the entry point into your Promise Land (Joshua 4:19, Numbers 14:40, Deuteronomy 8:2)

Lesson #2 – Build memorial stones to what God did (Joshua 4:20)

Lesson #3 – Stand Still and See the Breakthrough (Joshua 4:23-24)

SERMON RECAP

God's calling for the Israelites was to be a blessing to the nations and He fulfilled His promise to Abraham to lead them to the Promised Land. As believers, we also have a calling to reign in life (Romans 5:17), to be a blessing to all nations, to be godly stewards of this earth. God will lead and guide us, to possess and fulfil this call.

Elder Ee Yang shared with us 3 lessons we can learn from the Joshua Generation. It was a special generation that displayed faith to obey God's call. They also saw the fulfilment of God's promises as God used them - ordinary people to do extraordinary things and saw victory after victory. The Joshua Generation was an intergenerational group.

Lesson #1 – Humility is the entry point into your Promised Land (Joshua 4:19, Numbers 14:40, Deuteronomy 8:2)

- The Israelites conquered the land from the Jordan River, the lowest river on Earth.
- This is contrary to when the people attempted to enter the Promised Land from a high point as recorded in Numbers.
- God desires to humble us to remove us of pride as pride is a hinderance to our relationship with God. Pride is the desire to be independent of God. People who are humble attract the grace of God.

Lesson #2 – Build memorial stones to what God did (Joshua 4:20)

- Remembering God's provision and faithfulness removes our chronic habit of complaining.
- As humans, we tend to remember our mistakes and forget God's miracles. It takes intentionality to remember God's goodness.
- It also reminds us of what God has done and to be hungry for what He can do.

Lesson #3 – Stand Still and See the Breakthrough (Joshua 4:23-24)

- Similar to Exodus 14:13-14, God had commanded the people to stand still.
- However, the difference when the Israelites entered the Jordan River was that they needed to step into the Jordan River first.
- Through the lessons of the Israelites, we see how God also desires to teach us to walk by faith, and to keep believing.

As a Church, may we continue to humble ourselves and desire and hunger for more of God. May God fan in us a holy discontent for more of His presence in our lives, families and in RiverLife!



1. What is the reason that humility is important for us to step into what God has promised us? How does humility look like in our everyday lives?

Leader's Notes

This is a reflect question for members to consider what humility is and how it helps us grow in our walk with God. Leaders can also ask members to consider what Pride is and how it is a destructive hindrance in our own faith journey. Asking members to also explore what humility looks like in our everyday life allows us to reflect on areas that we may grow prideful / display false humility in and to share with one another to help each other be accountable.

Transition

Humility is key in our walk with God.

2. What are some "memorial stones" of God's goodness in your life? Share with the cell. How can we become a people that remembers God's goodness?

Leader's Notes

This question aims for members to share with the cell about the things they remember about God's goodness and faithfulness. It could have been an answered prayer, reminders of God's love or other breakthroughs in their lives. The question aims to encourage hope within the cell and to also recognise the importance of remembering God's character and how He will never fail even when our circumstances tell us to doubt His goodness.

Transition

It is important for us to develop intentionality in remembering God's goodness, even in the good and bad.

3. What is an area of your life where God is nudging you to stand in faith to believe?

Leader's Notes

A reflect and response question for members to share with the cell an area they are seeking for breakthrough in. Members can later break into groups to pray for one another.

Closing

May we continue to remember God's faithfulness and remember that God is not done with us! He desires for us to hunger for more of His presence in our lives and to live the abundant life He has called us to live.

Prayer Pointers

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray that we will heed the leading of the Holy Spirit and God's leadership.
- Pray that God will break the spirit of independence in us so that we will lean on Him completely.
- Pray for our family members and friends, especially for those who have yet to know Him.
- To commit 2024 to God and allow Him to work in us and through us as we continue to seek Him.

2. RiverLife

- Pray for our church, that as we enter into 2024, we will determine to grow into Christlikeness.
- Pray that we will position ourselves for God to mould us into the church He desires us to be.

3. World

- Continue to pray for the various nations that are at war:
 - a. Russia and Ukraine
 - b. Myanmar (Civil War) Pray for the situation where military service was made compulsory for man and woman between the ages of 18 and 35.
 - c. Israel & Hamas
- Continue to pray for countries that have an escalated conflict situation:
 - a. China and the Philippines in the South China Sea
 - b. North & South Korea
- Continue to pray for countries recovering from recent natural disasters:
 - a. Japan (Earthquake)
 - b. Iceland (Volcanic Eruption)
- Pray for Singapore
 - a. Pray against the rise of young drug abusers
 - b. Pray for a stability in the cost of living in Singapore
 - c. Pray for the Zika cluster in Boon Lay Place
- Pray for Indonesia as a new president has just been appointed.

4. Opportunities for Outreach

- ∉ Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
