

CELL DISCUSSION GUIDE

Date: 10 Mar 2024 | Speaker: Josh Yeoh | Topic: I go to prepare a place for you | Scripture: John 14:1-3

SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Be reminded of the Church's call as His bride and to be ready for His return
- 2. Be reminded of the comfort we can find in Jesus in the midst of our troubles.

SERMON SUMMARY

Josh preached from John 14.

In John 14, we see how Jesus reassures His disciples and reminds them that He will come for them again. Drawing from Jewish tradition of betrothal and wedding, Josh explains to us that Jesus has gone to prepare a place for us in the Father's house. He will then return for His bride (the church) and bring His bride into the Father's house, where we will be with Him for all eternity. Josh, encourages us to have the same posture as the disciples while we are waiting for the return of Christ – to believe in God as the Way, the Truth and the Light; and to behold Christ.

As we embark on the 21 days of prayer, may we come together and seek His face and purposes together!

SERMON RECAP

Josh preached from John 14 and about the idea of a home.

"Home is the place that when you arrive at, they have to take in you." - Robert Frost

Josh shares about how Jesus telling his disciples 3 things right after the washing of the disciples' feet.

- 1. One of them would betray him
- 2. He was leaving
- 3. Peter would disown him three times

In John 13, Jesus was deeply troubled; "Tarasso – to shake back and forth, to agitate and stir up; unsettle, throw into disorder". Jesus was also deeply troubled in John 11 (due to the death of Lazarus) and 12 (as He was contemplating the cross and what he would need to endure).

In the midst of the ongoing confusion in John 13, Jesus tells his disciples not to be troubled. In the same way, Jesus assures us not to let our hearts be troubled in the midst of our difficulties. Jesus' solution to a troubled heart is a relationship with him – "Believe in Me".

Josh also brings us back to the past where he shared about the similarities of our waiting for His second coming to the ancient Jewish weddings. Marriages were arranged and the process often took several years. Should the prospective bride accept the bethrothal, the bride would wait in her family home for the bridegroom while he prepared a place for her at his father's place. They would have limited interactions during this time. The groom would also not touch wine until they met again. The groom's father would give the call for the groom to bring his bride when he observed that the preparations are sufficient. When the groom is ready to come for his bride, the bride and her attendants would need to buy oil enough for two weeks and to keep watch with oil lamps for his coming. If the lamps are not burning when the groom comes, he will see it as the bride not wanting to keep to the marriage and leave.

Note: The word Mansion in the Bible when translated means "dwelling place".

In the midst of our troubles, Jesus reminds us that he is the bridesgroom and we are his. We can take comfort in the second coming of Christ (1 Thess 4:13 – 18 [NKJV]). He will come again. Will we respond to the promise of the Bridegroom?



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share with the cell concerning the concept of "eternal home". What does "eternal home" mean for you?

Leader's Notes

This question aims to help the members to reflect concerning that life that we will receive when Christ returns. It also challenges members to live for eternity rather than for our temporary home.

Transition

This world is not our eternal home. We are just passing through. Let us not build our homes here. We have a far greater inheritance in heaven when Christ returns. So, let us live for eternity and not for the temporary.

2. Jesus is our bridegroom and He assured us that He is coming again. How does this shape the way we live?

Leader's Notes

This question aims to let members reflect on how Jesus is our bridegroom – how does having this perspective shape the way we live – be it in our interactions, through delayed answers and in the way we live? Leaders can also get members to think about how disciples would live now while yearning and hungering for Him, and how this would look like in our everyday life.

Transition

We can find assurance knowing that Jesus is faithful and always with us.

3. In small groups, share an area of your life you are feeling troubled over and would like to commit to God.

Leader's Notes

This is a response question for members to share in small groups about their concerns or worries that they would like to commit to God. Leaders can also choose to tweak the question, asking members about times where they experienced trouble and how God met them then at their point of need.

Closing

Jesus is our bridegroom and we are His bride. May we continue to respond to His promise even as the church embarks on 21 days of prayer and fasting.

Prayer Pointers

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray that God will enable us to live in faith and obedience even as we seek and pursue Him
- Pray that we will continue to find delight in God even as we devote ourselves to the 21 days of Prayer and Fasting.

2. RiverLife

• Pray for our church, that as we enter into a season of prayer and fasting, that God will align all of our hearts and do what He needs to do so that we can live in a new normal that glorifies Him.

3. World

- Continue to pray for the various nations that are at war:
 - a. Russia and Ukraine
 - b. Myanmar (Civil War) Pray for the situation where military service was made compulsory for man and woman between the ages of 18 and 35.
 - c. Israel & Hamas
- Continue to pray for countries that have an escalated conflict situation:
 - a. China and the Philippines in the South China Sea
 - b. North & South Korea
- Continue to pray for countries recovering from recent natural disasters:
 - a. Japan (Earthquake)
 - b. Iceland (Volcanic Eruption)
- Pray for Singapore
 - a. Pray against the rise of young drug abusers
 - b. Pray for a stability in the cost of living in Singapore
 - c. Pray for the Zika cluster in Boon Lay Place
- Pray for Indonesia as a new president has just been appointed.
- Pray for the situation in Korea where there is a strike by the medical professionals which is affecting the sick.

4. Opportunities for Outreach

- ∉ Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
