SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

- 1. Understand the significance of the resurrection of Jesus Christ
- 2. Desire to live in and experience the resurrection power of Jesus Christ

SERMON SUMMARY

The resurrection is not just a true event; the resurrection is the event that our faith is based upon. As Christians, we can live in the resurrection power because Jesus is alive. Ps Joachim's message seeks to help RiverLifers understand the significance of the resurrection and how we can experience the resurrection power of Jesus Christ.

SERMON RECAP

Ps Joachim shared 4 ways we can experience the resurrection power of Christ:

#1: We can experience the fullness of a living faith

- "And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith" 1 Corinthians 15:14
- Because of the resurrection, we experience the fullness of God's promises in Jesus Christ. For example, we can experience the peace of God promised to us (Philippians 4:6-7, John 14:27)

#2: We can experience the depth of the Father's love

- The resurrection is not simply to be understood, it is to be experienced. When was the last time we experienced the living God?
- Ps Joachim shared that even as an earthly Father, his love for his own daughter compelled him to sacrifice himself for her. In the same way, the depth of God's Fatherly love for us (His children) caused Him to sacrifice for us.
- In the resurrection, we experience the true heart of God, the depth of the Father's love that God would indeed sacrifice His own Son for the world (Isaiah 53:4).

#3: The fullness of His resurrection power is now made available for us

- There is no power without the resurrection. "I want to know Christ yes, to **know the power of his resurrection** and participation in his sufferings, becoming like Him in his death (Philippians 3:10).
- This power is so evident in the life of the disciples "With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all" Acts 4:33
- "I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength He exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms." Ephesians 1:18-20.
- The church has been given power and authority:
 - to trample over snakes and scorpions and overcome all the power of the enemy (Luke 10:19)
 - for miracles (Book of Acts)
 - o for intimacy (Ephesians 1:18-23)

#4: The resurrection fuelled the church for the greatest revival, harvest and outpouring of the Holy Spirit



• The greatest outpouring of the Holy Spirit happened at Pentecost. The resurrection event sparked the initial flames in the young and waning church and fuelled them for the greatest harvest and outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What does the resurrection of Jesus Christ mean to you?

Leader's Notes

"But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the **first fruits** of those who have fallen asleep. For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man. For as in Adam all die, so **in Christ all will be made alive**." – 1 Corinthians 15:20-22. Jesus conquered sin and death – in Christ, we will be "made alive".

As believers, we can live in the resurrection power because Jesus is alive. Leaders can invite members to reflect on the significance of Jesus' resurrection in their own lives and what it means to them.

Transition

The same resurrection power that raised Christ from the dead is the same power that God has given us (his church) to overcome sin, and temptation, and to perform miracles.

2. Ps Joachim shared that "the resurrection is not simply to be understood, it is to be experienced". Share a time when you experienced the living God and His resurrection power. How did that experience impact you?

Leader's Notes

When was the last time you experienced the living God and His resurrection power? Leaders can invite cell members to share past instances where they experienced God – His deep love for them, or His resurrection power working in their lives, and how it had impacted them.

Transition

Let us desire to not only know and understand the resurrection as an event or concept, but to experience, live and immerse in the resurrection power in our daily lives.

3. Ps Joachim shared that the resurrection power has been made available for us (the church) to overcome the power of the enemy, for miracles, and for us to experience intimacy with Jesus. Share an area in your life in which you desire to experience the resurrection power of Christ.

Leader's Notes

Leaders can ask members to share situations in their lives which they want to see God's resurrection power work in – e.g. relationships that require His resurrection/restoration, the power to overcome habitual sin and temptation, chains and strongholds in their lives that need to be broken, healing of sickness etc.

Closing

In closing, the cell can spend some time praying for one another to experience the resurrection power and to see breakthroughs regarding the situations that have been shared.



Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

1. Sermon Application

- Pray for us to desire to live and immerse in the resurrection power of Jesus Christ.
- Pray that God will enlighten us to see the power that has been given to us (his church) to carry out His will.
- Pray for us to desire greater to see a greater outpouring of His Holy Spirit in our lives, families and in RiverLife Church.

2. RiverLife

• Pray for our church, that as we enter into a season of prayer and fasting, that God will align all of our hearts and do what He needs to do so that we can live in a new normal that glorifies Him.

3. World

- Continue to pray for the various nations that are at war:
 - a. Russia and Ukraine
 - b. Myanmar (Civil War) Pray for the situation where military service was made compulsory for man and woman between the ages of 18 and 35.
 - c. Israel & Hamas
 - Continue to pray for countries that have an escalated conflict situation:
 - a. China and the Philippines in the South China Sea
 - b. North & South Korea
- Continue to pray for countries recovering from recent natural disasters:
 - a. Taiwan (Earthquake)
 - b. Japan (Earthquake)
 - c. Iceland (Volcanic Eruption)
- Pray for the recovery and rebuilding efforts as a result of the collapsed bridge in Baltimore, USA.
- Pray for Singapore
 - a. Pray against the rise of young drug abusers
 - b. Pray for a stability in the cost of living in Singapore

4. Opportunities for Outreach

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
