**Topic:** From the Temple to the Dead Sea | **Scripture:** Various Passages

## SPIRITUAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of the sermon discussion, cell members will:

1. Reflect about being the temple of the Holy Spirit
2. Consider next steps to be involved in caring for the community.

## SERMON SUMMARY

Elder Ee Yang shares about the vision from **Ezekiel 47** – where a river of water from the temple flows to the Dead Sea. The river is the prophetic picture of the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives (**John 7: 37 – 39**).

The temple in the Old Testament is where God dwells, a house of worship and prayer, and a place of sanctification and purification. The Church in the New Testament plays the same role. However, believers of Christ are now the temple of the Holy Spirit (**1 Corinthians 3:16 – 17**). The Holy Spirit sanctifies us (**1 Corinthians 6:11**) and heals us (**Acts 10:38**).

In **Ezekiel 47:3 – 12**, we also see how the river flowed into the Dead Sea, bringing life wherever it goes. This is a picture of how God empowers us through His Holy Spirit to be witnesses to the communities that need to hear the Good News (**Acts 1:8, Luke 4:18 – 19**).

## SERMON RECAP

“Revival is a work of the Holy Spirit wherein He moves amongst God’s people and unbelievers. The person and work of the Holy Spirit is crucial. He must not be ignored, seen as just an influence, or denied His place as shown in Scripture”. – *Dr Martyn Lloyd-Jones*

The river of God begins at the temple (**Ezekiel 47:1**). The temple of God as mentioned in **Ezekiel 47:1** is God’s dwelling place, a house of worship and prayer, a place of sanctification and purification. Similarly, the Church in the New Testament is the place where believers encounter the manifest presence of God, where believers come together for worship and prayer and fellowship as a spiritual community and where God sanctifies us through the work of the Holy Spirit. We now play a similar role as the temple of the Holy Spirit (**1 Corinthians 3:16-17**).

God has been doing a work amongst us through the various events in our Church – the River is flowing in our midst (**Ezekiel 47:9**)!

The destination of the River is towards the Dead Sea – it represents the community and the nations, places that are spiritually dead. The River becomes fuller as it flows (**Ezekiel 47:3 – 5**) and God empowers us to be His witnesses as we go into the community and the nations (**Acts 1:8**).

Elder Ee Yang encouraged us to rise up to our call to be a house of healing and restoration, a pillar of light and fire to our community and nations (**Luke 4:18 -19**). As we answer the call, we can be assured that God has anointed us to do His work as we walk in step with Him.

# Discussion Questions

- 1. We are the temple of the Holy Spirit. Share with the cell what you understand by this statement and how this acts as a reminder for you to live for Jesus in everyday life.**

## Leader's Notes

As a cell, discuss what it means that we are the temple of the Holy Spirit. Members can share with each other about their understanding of this and to consider how this has or had impacted the areas of their lives (eg. in their routines, decisions, relationship with God and others, etc.) Members can also share how holding on to this truth influences their daily life.

## Transition

God has granted us a great privilege in making us His dwelling places.

- 2. What comes to your mind when you think of community care? Share with the cell some possible barriers or hindrances you face when it comes to serving the community.**

## Leader's Notes

This question is for the cell to consider what they understand about caring for the community. If suitable, leaders can invite some members who have participated more actively in community care to share about how they had started in it. This question also aims for them to share about their possible challenges when exploring about serving the community i.e., not sure how to get started, fears and concerns. Members can also share how they overcame these concerns with the cell.

## Transition

God will move our hearts to love others like He has loved us.

- 3. Ezekiel 47 shows us that the river gives life wherever it goes. It ultimately goes into the Red Sea – a picture of the church, through the power of the Holy Spirit, going into the world and being the salt and the light. Share an experience you had serving the community – how was the experience for you? OR Share about a community that God is prompting you to serve and explore in.**

## Leader's Notes

Members can share about a time where they had interacted with giving to the community or in mission trip, and for them to share their reflections about giving and serving. Members can also share about communities that God has placed in their hearts to bless, and the cell can also come alongside by praying for them or to consider helping out in that community in whatever time commitment or capacity God leads.

## Closing

God has set us apart to be blessings to those around us. May we be like the **Ezekiel 47** river – one that flows out of the presence of God into the world, bringing life wherever it goes!

Consider dividing the group into micro-groups for a deeper time of sharing as well as praying for the following items:

## 1. Sermon Application

- Pray that we will remember we are the temple of Holy Spirit and to be people that desire deep communion with him.
- Pray that God will continue to allow us to be ready and God-conscious, to be deliberate in our interactions with others and to have a heart to serve others in need.

## 2. RiverLife

- Pray for our church, that as we emerge from a season of prayer and fasting, that God will align all of our hearts and do what He needs to do so that we can live in a new normal that glorifies Him.

## 3. World

- Continue to pray for the various nations that are at war:
  - a. Russia and Ukraine
  - b. Myanmar (Civil War) – Pray for the situation where military service was made compulsory for man and woman between the ages of 18 and 35.
  - c. Israel & Hamas – Pray for the truce talks between Israel and Palestine in Cairo, that a peaceful resolution can be reached.
- Continue to pray for countries that have an escalated conflict situation:
  - a. Japan, China and the Philippines in the South China Sea
  - b. North & South Korea
- Continue to pray for countries recovering from recent natural disasters:
  - a. Taiwan (Earthquake)
  - b. Indonesia (Volcanic Eruption)
  - c. South East Asia – Heatwave across various countries
  - d. Canada (Wildfire)
- Pray for Singapore
  - a. Pray for PM Lawrence Wong and his cabinet as they begin a new chapter for Singapore
  - b. Pray for a stability in the cost of living in Singapore
  - c. Pray for those affected by the Singapore Airlines's SQ321 turbulence incident
- Other Global Issues
  - a. Pray for the situation in Malaysia where there is a heightened security alert due to acts of terrorism. Do also pray for safety for all church camps that will be happening there in the June/July period.
  - b. Continue to pray for the medical strike in South Korea
  - c. Pray for the situation in various parts of Indonesia where 58 people are killed by cold lava and flash floods.

- Ask the Lord to bless us as we step out to reach a pre-believer.
- Ask the Lord to grant you opportunities to reach out to a non-believing loved one, friend, or colleague this week as we seek to mature in Christlikeness.
